## 2019 Fees

\$150 per cheerleader for the fall football season. Basketball may be added for an additional \$50. This registration will open at a later period.

Fee includes uniform, warmup pants & jacket, bow, pom-poms, briefs, & socks. White tennis shoes will be the parent's responsibility.

## Practices

2 days a week at Fallen Timbers Middle School

Our first week will be Monday, 7/29 & Wednesday, 7/31 from 6 – 8pm

Normal practice will be held Mondays and Thursdays from 6pm – 7:30pm

\*\*\*Practices may reduce after games begin\*\*\*

Cheerleaders on K – 2<sup>nd</sup> grade squads will move to practicing from 6pm – 7pm once squads are established. Notifications will be made at practice and via email.

## Games

Will be 1 day a week for all squads beginning the weekend after Labor Day

Saturdays at 10am for K – 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Squads

Sundays travel Squads rotate locations and times

\*\*\*Special accommodations can be made for squad placement based on family football schedules, siblings, etc.\*\*\*

The cheerleaders will be learning basic cheer skills.

## Coaches Needed

When registering your cheerleader, there is an option to sign up as a team parent.
